



### RoHS 3 Directive (2015/863/EU)

RoHS stands for Restriction of Hazardous Substances. The RoHS directive restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment:

- Lead
- Mercury
- Cadmium
- Hexavalent Chromium
- Polybrominated biphenyls
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate
- Dibutyl phthalate
- Benzyl butyl phthalate
- Diisobutyl phthalate



The intent of the restriction of these hazardous materials is to contribute to the protection of human health and the environment. The deadline for compliance to the RoHS directive for most electronic equipment is July 2019.

Two categories of equipment are currently exempt; Category 8 Medical Equipment and Category 9 Monitoring and Control Instruments.
